**Registration**

A minimum number of participants are required for the class to move forward as scheduled. If the minimum is not met by the Thursday before the classes are to begin, the classes will be cancelled and registrants notified.

**Topic Description**

This session is required for any operator who wants to be approved to conduct Level 1 or 2 assessments under the RTCR. Small Water Advanced, W3 and W4 operators can conduct Level 1 assessments without this 8.0-hr training; similarly, W3 and W4 operators can conduct Level 2 assessments without this training. All other operators are required to attend an 8.0-hr RTCR training to be approved to conduct assessments. Samplers and non-certified operations staff must become certified before being able to conduct RTCR assessments, even with this 8.0-hr training.

The New Mexico Environmental department (NMED) has contracted with Daniel B. Stephens & Associates, Inc. (DBS&A) to provide this FREE training to operators and board members. Participants will receive 8.0 training credits for attendance.
